## Notes:

- 1) Music is a 4-bar A repeated, followed by a 10-bar B.
- 2) The Sicilian circle Improper formation is like a normal Sicilian circle but you and your partner are swapped over so the lady is on the man's left.
- 3) This is a variant of the Institute, but with partner interaction to satisfy American sensibilities.
- 4) The tune is published in "Country Bumpkin".

## Dance:

A1 1-4 Partner back-to-back

A2 1-4 Partner 2-hand turn 1½ **or** swing (*end facing neighbor*)

B 1-6 Rights & lefts (*3 changes, start neighbor right hand*)  
7-10 (*With the one you meet*) swing (*end proper, facing in or out, opposite your partner who will be improper with respect to you*)
