## Notes:

- 2) My change is to eliminate a 2-bar neighbour allemande left at the top of A1 and to allow for a balance into the Box The Gnat.
- 3) Avon Tyrrell is an old country mansion in the New Forest where Mark wasd calling for the Halsway Manor Folk Dance Club.

A1 1-4 Lines forward & back  
5-6 Partner balance (*right*)  
7-8 Partner Box the Gnat, **into**

A2 1-4 Star right  
5-8 Ladies chain

B1 1-4 Promenade over  
5-8 Ladies chain

B2 1-6 Ladies flutterwheel  $1\frac{1}{4}$  (*ladies right hand turn  $\frac{1}{2}$ , pick up partner, wheel all the way and a quarter more to face along*)  
**[all home]**  
7-8 Pass through along (*and take hands in line*)
